

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

RE: The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:
Vision Convenience Store 10648 101 Street NW Edmonton T5H 2S1.

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The facility is not supplied with hot and cold running potable water.
- b. Hand soap and single use paper towels are not supplied at the washroom hand sink.
- c. Open food, such as coffee with Coffee Mate and sugar, are being sold to customers contrary to permit restrictions.
- d. Donuts from an unknown source are being served at the facility.
- e. Pest control records are not available for review.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The facility is not supplied with hot and cold running potable water. This is in contravention of Section 17(1)(f)(i) of the Food Regulation, which states that "an operator must ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment is supplied with hot and cold running water that is safe for human consumption and available in quantities sufficient to meet the needs of the commercial food establishment"
- b. Hand soap and single use paper towels are not supplied at the washroom hand sink. This is in contravention of Section 30(4) of the Food Regulation, which states that "the handwashing stations referred to in section 17(1)(e) must be maintained and kept supplied."
- c. Open food, such as coffee with Coffee Mate and sugar, are being sold to customers contrary to permit restrictions. This is in contravention of Section 9(4) of the Food Regulation which states that "an operator must ensure that the terms and conditions of the permit are not contravened."
- d. Donuts from an unknown source are being served at the facility. This is in contravention of Section 22(1) of the Food Regulation, which states that "subject to this section, a commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity."

- e. Pest control records are not available for review. This is in contravention of Section 21(2) of the Food Regulation, which states that “a written record of all pest control measures used in the commercial food establishment and surrounding area, premises and facilities referred to in subsections (1) and (1.1) must be maintained.”

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Restore potable water to the facility.
 - b. Supply washroom hand sink with soap and paper towel.
 - c. Cease the service of any food that is not prepackaged.
 - d. Ensure that all food is obtained from an approved source.
 - e. Implement a pest monitoring program and keep records of implemented program.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by March 12, 2026.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
