

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Crooked Creek Cones - Crooked Creek General Store Ltd. 2017
"the Owner"

RE: The food establishment located in Crooked Creek, Alberta and municipally described as:
Crooked Creek Cones, NW 26-71-26-W5M

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There is a single sink basin which is inadequate for manual dishwashing, hand washing, food handling, and cleaning activities.
- b. There are packaged food products and food packaging being stored on the floor.
- c. Soiled wet wiping cloths are being left on the espresso machine and inside the single sink basin between uses and are not being submerged in a sanitizer solution.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. There is a single sink basin which is inadequate for manual dishwashing, hand washing, food handling, and cleaning activities. This is in contravention to sections 17(1) and 28(1)&(2) of the AR 31/2006, which states an operator shall ensure that a commercial food establishment is so designed as to facilitate the effective cleaning and sanitizing of it and all equipment, utensils and surfaces with which food comes in to contact in it, and that a commercial food establishment must have all the facilities, equipment and utensils that are necessary to ensure its safe operation and maintenance and all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination, respectively.
- b. There are packaged food products and food packaging being stored on the floor. This is in contravention to sections 23 & 28 of the AR 31/2006, which states that all food, equipment, and utensils must be stored in a manner that protects them from contamination.
- c. Soiled wet wiping cloths are being left on the espresso machine and inside the single sink basin between uses and are not being submerged in a sanitizer solution. This is in contravention of section 28(2) of the AR 31/2006, which requires a commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Ensure there are adequate sinks basins for dishwashing, hand washing, food handling and cleaning activities. Install additional sink basins: 2-compartment sink minimum.
 - b. Ensure all food products and food packaging are stored 6 inches off the ground.
 - c. Ensure an approved food safe sanitizer solution is prepared in a dedicated and labelled container for wiping cloths to be submerged and sanitized between uses. The sanitizer must be refreshed throughout the day and the concentration verified with corresponding test strips. This is to be documented.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1(a) shall be completed before resuming seasonal operation for the 2027 season or by May 15, 2027, whichever is first.
3. The work referred to in paragraph 1(b)(c) shall be completed by September 23, 2026.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
