

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: **Synergy GP Inc.**
"the Owner"

RE: The food establishment located in Grande Prairie, Alberta and municipally described as:

**Popeyes Louisiana Kitchen
13213 100 Street Grande Prairie, AB T8X 0V5**

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The facility was operating and serving food to the public while the sewer was backing up inside the kitchen area.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The facility operating while sewer is backing up inside the kitchen area is in contravention of Section 23(1)(a), which states that "*All food used or to be used in a commercial food establishment must be protected from contamination*"
- b. The facility operating while sewer is backing up inside the kitchen area is in contravention of Section 23(1)(b), which states that "*All food used or to be used in a commercial food establishment must be handled in a sanitary manner*"

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Nuisance & General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 and exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- c. The facility operating while sewer is backing up inside the kitchen area is in contravention of Section 2(1) which states that "*No person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance*".
- d. The facility operating while sewer is backing up inside the kitchen area is in contravention of Section 2(2)(a) which states that "*Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a person who creates, commits or maintains any premises in a condition that is or might become injurious or dangerous to the public health or that might hinder in any manner the*

prevention or suppression of disease is deemed to have created, committed or maintained a nuisance".

- e. The facility operating while sewer is backing up inside the kitchen area is in contravention of Section 2(2)(e) which states that "*Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a person who creates, commits or maintains any accumulation or deposit of offensive matter, waste or manure wherever situated, that is or might become injurious or dangerous to the public health or that might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease is deemed to have created, committed or maintained a nuisance".*

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Contact a certified plumber to identify the cause of the sewer backup and make necessary repairs.
 - b. Once repairs are completed, the entire kitchen must be cleaned and sanitized.
 - c. Discard any food that is contaminated by sewer water.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
