

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER Boil Water Order

To: Town of Rainbow Lake
"the Owner"

RE: The Drinking Water Supply located in Rainbow Lake, Alberta and municipally described as: area supplied by the Rainbow Lake Waterworks System located north of Highway 58, excluding Commercial Road.

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have received a report about the above noted drinking water supply pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such report disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted drinking water supply which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Drinking water in the distribution system may be unsafe for consumption due to depressurization of the line and a shutdown of the treatment system for a repair to the system.

AND WHEREAS such report disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 exist in and about the above noted Drinking Water Supply, namely:

- a. Drinking water in the distribution system may be unsafe for consumption due to depressurization of the line and a shutdown of the treatment system for a repair to the system which is in contravention of the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation Section 11, which states "Where a person provided a source of water that the person intends to be used or realizes or ought to realize will be used by the public for human consumption, the person shall ensure that the water is potable".

AND WHEREAS by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted Drinking Water Supply is hereby declared **unfit for human consumption**;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately issues a Boil Water Advisory to all users of the above noted Drinking Water Supply.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted drinking water supply, namely:
 - b. Complete appropriate turnover of the potable water distribution system in accordance with AEPA direction.

- c. After appropriate turnover of the distribution system has been completed, one set of satisfactory bacteriological water samples is required. Bacteriological water samples must be submitted to the Alberta Provincial Laboratory of Public Health and must be representative of the potable water distribution system.
3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of the undersigned, or an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, that this order shall remain in effect.

The above conditions were noted at the time of receipt of the report and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
