

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: AVENUE LIVING (2014) GP LTD.; Avenue Living Communities Ltd.; Madison Howell;

Mae Cote "the Owner"

RE: Those housing premises located in Brooks, Alberta and municipally described as: 524 1A

Avenue E, Unit 204

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Grout between tile and edge of kitchen counter was worn and accumulating food buildup was accumulating. A sticker was covering a portion of the counter tiles.
- b. Vertical guard rails were missing from the balcony guardrail on the east side, creating gaps wider than five (5) inches.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Grout between tile and edge of the kitchen counter was worn and accumulating food buildup was accumulating. A sticker was covering a portion of the counter tiles. This contravenes section IV(14)(a)(iii) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Every housing premises shall be provided with a food preparation area, which includes a counter or table used for food preparation which shall be of sound construction and furnished with surfaces that are easily cleaned.
- b. Vertical guard rails were missing from the balcony guardrail on the east side, creating gaps wider than five (5) inches. This contravenes section III(3)(c)(i) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that:

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Remove sticker, clean between grout and resurface tile with grout, or replace counter.
 - b. Install the missing vertical guard rails in compliance with Alberta Building Code.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by August 1, 2025.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
