

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: AVENUE LIVING (2014) GP LTD.; Avenue Living Communities Ltd.; Madison Howell;

Mae Cote "the Owner"

RE: Those housing premises located in Brooks, Alberta and municipally described as: 524 1A

Avenue E, Unit 303

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a) Hot water was continuously running from the bathtub faucet. The bathroom sink faucet was also continuously running. Neither fixtures could be shut off.
- b) The bedroom window did not lock. The patio door locking mechanism was misaligned and did not lock.
- c) The bathroom sink was etched and rusting.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a) Hot water was continuously running from the bathtub faucet. The bathroom sink faucet was also continuously running. Neither fixtures could be shut off. This contravenes section IV(6)(a,c) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: The plumbing system and the sanitary drainage system or private sewage disposal system, as the case may be, including drains, fixtures, traps, vents, stacks, waste disposal facilities, pumpout sewage holding tanks, septic tanks and the disposal system shall be maintained in a proper operating condition. All plumbing fixtures shall be serviceable, free from leaks, trapped and vented to the outside.
- b) The bedroom window did not lock. The patio door locking mechanism was misaligned and did not lock. This contravenes section III(3)(a) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Exterior windows and doors shall be capable of being secured.
- c) The bathroom sink was etched and rusting. This contravenes section IV(6)(c),(7) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: All plumbing fixtures shall be serviceable, free from leaks, trapped and vented to the outside. Except where exempt by regulation, every housing premises shall be provided with plumbing fixtures of an approved type consisting of at least a flush toilet, a wash basin, and a bathtub or shower.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Repair bathtub faucet and bathroom sink faucet plumbing fixtures so that the water can be properly turned off.
- b. Install a proper operating locking mechanism on the window and repair the lock on patio door or install a new secure patio door.
- c. Replace the bathroom sink with one that can be properly cleaned.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by August 1, 2025.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
