### **KEY ACHIEVEMENTS**

Since their inception in 2009, Advisory Council members have shared advice and feedback from their communities with Alberta Health Services (AHS). They've held public meetings and engagement activities virtually or in locations throughout their geographic area that further contributed to improving healthcare services in Alberta.

In 2023-24. the Oldman River Health Advisory Council (ORHAC) focused on its work commitment priorities, which included: Alternate Levels of Care – Seniors and Continuing Care, Access to Care and Addiction and Mental Health.

The Council hosted three meetings and one event where participants gained insights on South Zone Healthcare Planning, Connect Care, Health Link 811, Milk River Attraction & Retention Committee, Rural Health Professions Action Plan (RhPAP). Council also had the opportunity to tour the Wisdom Room when they met at the Chinook Regional Hospital.

In November, Council members met with Health Minister Adriana LaGrange to learn of the Government of Alberta's plans to refocus the health system; they later met with Parliamentary Secretary for Rural Health, MLA Martin Long, to talk about their successes and potential opportunities for the new Regional Advisory Councils (RAC) being established by the Government of Alberta.

A few Council members provided input on South Zone Healthcare Planning committees in the following areas: primary care, continuing care, addiction and mental health, health promotion and the social determinants of health, and acute care sustainability.

The Chair, Vice Chair and Council Coordinator met monthly with AHS South Zone leadership to ensure Council-related matters and kudos could be addressed in a timely manner.

### Community concerns shared with Zone leadership included:

- Physician recruitment and retention.
- Milk River Clinic Emergency Department closures.

### Council engaged with AHS on the following topics:

- South Zone Healthcare Planning.
- Physician recruitment and retention.
- AHS' 10-year Health Plan.
