

## **KEY ACHIEVMENTS**

Since their inception in 2009, Advisory Council members have shared advice and feedback from their communities with Alberta Health Services (AHS). They've held public meetings and engagement activities virtually or in locations throughout their geographic area that further contributed to improving healthcare services in Alberta.

In 2023-24, the Palliser Triangle Health Advisory Council (PTHAC) focused on providing information on engaging health topics of interest within their communities. This included: information about the new ambulatory care wing and changes to the service delivery model of care at the Medicine Hat Regional Hospital; Health Link 811; Wellspring Cancer Support Alberta; Connect Care implementation; and South Zone Healthcare Planning.

A few members participated in working groups to provide input on South Zone Healthcare Planning in the following areas: primary care, continuing care, addiction and mental health, health promotion and the social determinants of health, and acute care sustainability.

In November, Advisory Council members met with Health Minister Adriana LaGrange to learn of the Government of Alberta's plans to refocus the health system; they later met with Parliamentary Secretary for Rural Health, MLA Martin Long, to talk about their successes and potential opportunities for the new Regional Advisory Councils (RAC) being established by the Government of Alberta.

In January, Council met with Premier Danielle Smith, in her capacity as Brooks-Medicine Hat MLA, to share their thoughts on healthcare challenges in their corner of the province.

AHS South Zone leadership continued its support of the HAC. They provided timely and transparent dialogue with the HAC and public who attended its meetings and events. The Rural Health Professionals Action Plan (RhPAP) continued to bring updates to community as a valued partner of the HAC.

The Chair and Council Coordinator met monthly with AHS South Zone leadership bringing good news stories and community health-related concerns to their attention.

#### Community concerns shared with Zone leadership included:

- Access to addictions and mental health resources.
- Lab services.
- Staffing shortage at Oyen Big County Hospital, and general workforce issues.
- Emergency Medical Services (EMS).
- Whooping cough outbreak.
- Medicine Hat Regional Hospitals breast feeding policy.

#### Council engaged with AHS on the following topics:

- South Zone Healthcare Planning.
- Connect Care Implementation.
- Aging in Place Engagement Session for Older Albertans and Caregivers/Partners.

Council hosted four meetings and events through the year with 111 public in attendance.
