



ABORH Compatibility for Blood Components

- For Platelets, the first choice is the same ABO type as the patient, however, any ABO group may be safely transfused.
Note: Low titre platelets may have "Low Anti-A/B" on its label indicating compatibility that differs from this chart.
- Rh is not a factor in Plasma compatibility.
- Rh Negative patients may receive Rh Positive RBC in inventory shortages, bleeding emergencies, and when many RBC units are required such as massive hemorrhage situations. If this occurs, RhIG may be indicated. Refer to the [RhIG Product Monograph](#).
