



**ABORH Compatibility for Blood Components**

- For Platelets and Cryoprecipitate, the first choice is the same ABO type as the patient, however, any ABO group may be safely transfused.  
Note: Low titre platelets may have a label indicating compatibility that differs from this chart. Eg: “All Groups”
- Rh is not a factor in Plasma or cryoprecipitate compatibility.
- Rh Negative patients may receive Rh Positive RBC in inventory shortages, bleeding emergencies, and when many RBC units are required such as massive hemorrhage situations. If this occurs, RhIG may be indicated. Refer to the [RhIG Product Monograph](#)
