Key Message

- "Nocardia Culture" will no longer be available as a separate orderable in Connect Care.
- If *Nocardia* spp. is clinically suspected, please include this in the "Suspected Organism" field when ordering and submitting a specimen for culture.
- If *Nocardia* spp. has been isolated, it will be reported under the accession corresponding to the specimen from which it was isolated.

Background

- Culture for *Nocardia* spp. continues to be performed at both Edmonton Base Lab and Calgary DSC microbiology laboratories. It remains integrated within routine culture protocols utilizing routine and selective media, and extended incubation.
- The Nocardia Culture orderable is not being utilized by laboratories for reporting of culture results, which has resulted in confusion when reviewing results.
