# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

## **Key Message**

- As of October 28, 2024, VZV IgG equivocal results will no longer be reported.
- Results will continue to be available on Netcare and sent to the submitter as per usual.
- Turn-around-times (TATs) will not be affected.

### **Background**

- Previously, VZV IgG results would fall into three categories: positive, equivocal and negative.
- To align with recent FDA and Health Canada requirements, Diasorin Liaison has optimized their VZV IgG assay (Liaison VZV IgG HT) to eliminate the equivocal zone.
- The new Diasorin Liaison VZV IgG HT assay will replace the pre-existing assay (Liaison VZV IgG) to accommodate this reporting change.
  - Only positive or negative VZV IgG results will be reported.
