Key Message

- A NEW Central Zone Fine Needle Aspiration Clinic opened in Red Deer on January 1st, 2025.
- Located at the Red Deer Regional Hospital. Clinic hours are bi-weekly Mondays 1200-1600 hours.
- The clinic performs fine needle aspiration on palpable and non-palpable superficial lesions (lumps and bumps).
- To refer a patient, a Fine Needle Aspiration Clinic Patient Referral Form has been developed (see below)

Background

 This is a new service offered to Central Zone physicians and patients to assist with a wait times in the region for thyroid FNAs and offer a new service for any other "lump or "bump" that would be amenable to superficial (<3cm deep) ultrasound guided FNA by a pathologist.

How this will impact you

- Clinicians will now have the ability to book FNAs through the lab instead of Diagnostic Imaging.
- There is a chance that the patient may not meet criteria set out and will be rejected. Such examples include, not providing all the necessary information on the referral form or if the lesion is deemed too deep (>3cm) or is located to close to critical anatomical structures.
- If the patient has 2 no-shows, they will be discharged from our clinic and a new referral will need to be made.
