RE:	Temporary Referral of Complement C3 (C3) Testing to DSC Chemistry	

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Key Message

• Effective May 05, 2025, Edmonton Base Lab will temporarily refer Complement C3 testing to the Diagnostic and Scientific Center (DSC) Laboratory in Calgary. Please note the change in the reference interval.

Background

- Due to global supply chain shortage identified by the vendor, reagents used for C3 measurement at Edmonton Base Lab on the Siemens Atellica are currently unavailable.
- The DSC Chemistry assay for C3 is performed by immunoturbidimetry on the Roche Cobas analyzer and has a different reference interval.
- This change does <u>not</u> impact C3 testing performed at the University of Alberta Hospital.

How this will impact you

- The reference interval for C3 will change (see table below). Reports in Connect Care and Netcare will reflect the correct reference interval.
- Testing at DSC is performed daily.
- Follow up communication will be issued once the reagent supply is re-established.

Complement C3 reference interval	0.80 – 2.10 g/L	0.60 - 1.60 g/L

Action Required

- Be aware of the change in the reference interval for C3 measurement.
- Rebaselining is recommended for C3 in patients that require serial measurements due to lack of result interchangeability and use of a different reference interval.
