Key Message

- A new provincial immunohistochemistry (IHC) requisition has been developed and is now available on AHS and APL websites
- Legacy requisitions for Edmonton and Calgary have been reviewed and amalgamated to support consistent ordering in Connect Care and standardize practices across the province.

Background

• The immunohistochemistry requisition has been updated to comply with current HIA standards and support consistent ordering practices in the province.

Action Required

- For sites on Connect Care: order IHC tests in Connect Care according to local practices and procedures.
