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#### Key Message

- Effective November 5, 2023 all blood gas samples will be performed by Rural Lab Staff
- This change will impact South Zone Rural Laboratories and Respiratory Therapists, excluding Pincher Creek Hospital
- This is a change in practice for Rural Respiratory Therapists who currently perform blood gas testing

#### Background

- Historically, Respiratory Therapists or Physicians may have analyzed arterial blood gas on the lab i-STAT instrument
- Due to the workflow and connectivity of the analyzers, Connect Care does not have the ability to have shared devices between departments
- Lab i-STAT devices will only be used by laboratory staff beginning November 5, 2023

#### How this will impact you

- Lab staff will continue to perform all arterial blood gas testing on the i-STAT if the analyzer is located in the lab
- Respiratory Therapists are encouraged to inform the lab before collecting an arterial blood gas sample to ensure the i-STAT is not in use
- Sample stability will remain at 30 minutes. If a respiratory sample is from ED or acute care, the expected turnaround time is 15 minutes.

#### **Action Required**

- Respiratory Therapists and Physicians will continue to collect blood gas samples
- Lab Staff will perform the blood gas testing on the i-STAT Analyzer
