Key Message:

- Effective **October 27, 2020**, the reference for pH Fluid will be updated to reflect the APL provincially standardized reference interval of pH Fluid: ≥7.200.
- These changes will be reflected in the Lab Information System (LIS).

• Reference intervals are evidence based and have been agreed upon by the provincial reference interval harmonization working group.
