PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

• Effective **November 10, 2020**, requests for Fluid Osmolality must be approved directly by the clinical biochemist or pathologist.

Why this is Important:

- Fluid Osmolality is rarely required.
- In order to ensure correct result interpretation since no reference interval exists, it is imperative that the ordering physician speak directly with the clinical biochemist or pathologist on call.

Action Required:

- Be familiar with the update in Meditech to make OSMFLU non-orderable from units.

- After approval has been obtained, please call 403-343-4749 to place the order. Be prepared to provide the name of the Biochemist or Pathologist that granted approval.
