Key Message

With the Connect Care Launch 4 rollout, there will be changes to result reporting for POCT devices that may require workflow and clinical practice changes. A controlled connectivity rollover of POCT devices to the POCT AegisPOC data management middleware, and then into the provincial Clinical Information System (Epic) will begin on May 28, 2022.

How this will impact you

Legacy workflows will be modified. Please see below information on new POCT workflows, which can also be found on the provincial <u>APL Provincial POCT Insite page</u> in the <u>Connect Care Resources</u> section.

Unconnected devices:

Patient results from <u>unconnected</u> POCT devices will require **manual** entry into Epic using the **Epic** "**Enter/Edit**" function directly by the person performing the test. See your clinical practice area Connect Care training documents for instruction. The following documents will help guide workflows for unconnected POCT devices:

Adhere to the following requirements when performing POCT:

- <u>Healthcare Professionals / Providers</u> must:
 - o Receive POCT certification requirements to access devices.
 - > Zone POCT department will provide device access through the POCT middleware system.
 - Barcode scan or manually enter your AHS employee ID barcode number to access POCT devices.
- Patient identification:
 - Each patient must be identified using the valid, Epicgenerated patient ID encounter (Contact Serial Number [CSN]).
 - Use of the <u>correct</u> CSN is **REQUIRED**.
 - CSN usage ensures that results flow correctly and uninterrupted to Epic.
