Key Message

With the Connect Care Launch 7 rollout, there will be changes to result reporting for POCT devices that may require workflow and clinical practice changes. A controlled connectivity rollover of POCT devices to the POCT AegisPOC data management middleware, and then into the provincial Clinical Information System (Epic), will begin on November 5, 2023.

How this will impact you

As with all previous Connect Care Launches, legacy practice around ordering POCT and associated legacy workflows will be modified.



Provincial POCT - Request for POCT Device Test and or Support Form

Healthcare Professional/Provider Requirements: Be aware of the training and certification requirements in order to perform POCT and gain access for correct result reporting in AegisPOC and Epic Beaker.

Reporting Changes: Be aware of the POCT result reporting changes and workflow requirements coming to your clinical practice area with Connect Care Launch 7. Be aware of the required Epic patient identifier for POCT. The correct patient encounter CSN (Contact Serial Number) is required for patient results to transmit correctly to the Epic health record and Netcare.
