RE:	Discontinuation of Blood Storage Refrigerator at PLC OR

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Key Message

- Effective **August 30**, **2021**, blood components and products will be transported to the OR in sealed coolers instead of storing blood components or products in the OR at PLC.
- Boxes are **not** to be opened until immediately prior to transfusion.
- There will be no change to the process of ordering blood components or products.

Background

• Current blood storage refrigerators external to TM departments are being eliminated to fulfill Health Canada requirements for monitoring blood products and components.

Action Required

- Blood Transport boxes can be stored in operating theatres. They will be decontaminated upon return to TM.
- Patient information and contents will be on the exterior of the box for initial clerical check. Full clerical checks are to be done **immediately** prior to transfusing.
- As soon as the case is complete, boxes must be returned to TM due to limited supply.
