Re: Discontinuation of Digoxin testing at St. Mary's Hospital in Camrose and Wainwright

Key Message:

- Effective **February 1, 2021**, digoxin will no longer be tested on-site at St. Mary's Hospital and Wainwright Health Centre.
- Specimens will be referred to DynaLife Medical Laboratory in Edmonton.
- STAT requests will be cabbed to Edmonton with anticipated turnaround time of 4-6 hours.

Why this is Important:

 Requests for Digoxin assays are not frequent enough to justify maintaining costly methodology and quality assurance on-site.

Action Required:

 No change in ordering is required. Samples will be redirected automatically by the laboratory.
