- Effective Monday May 31, 2021, gentamycin, tobramycin, and digoxin will no longer be tested on-site at MCH and GNH.
- Specimens will be referred to Royal Alexandra Hospital (RAH).

Background

• Declining orders for gentamycin, tobramycin, and digoxin at MCH and GNH are not frequent enough to justify maintaining costly methodology and quality assurance on-site.

Action Required

• No change in ordering is required. Samples collected at MCH and GNH will be redirected automatically.
