Re: Discontinuation of Urine Hemosiderin Testing

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Effective March 8, 2021, South Zone Hematology will discontinue on site urine hemosiderin testing.
- Testing will be referred to Calgary Diagnostic Scientific Centre (DSC) and then out of province to In Common Laboratories, ON, CA.
- Test results will be available in Netcare.
- Estimated turn-around-time will be approximately 1 week.
- Test can be ordered as HEMSURRO (referred out test code).

Why this is important:

- Current urine hemosiderin testing volume is very low (1 test per year) and it is not justifiable to continue with on-site testing.
- APL continues to review practices with the goal to optimize test utilization and cost effectiveness in providing quality testing for patient care.
