 Communications Management (DATA CM) is depleted. Access the requisition via AHS website or the
 Transfusion Medicine website.

How this will impact you

• The current Edmonton Zone Transfusion Medicine requisition will need to be printed off until live with the provincial TSIN system.

Action Required

Access the current <u>Edmonton Zone Transfusion Medicine requisition</u> via the Edmonton Zone tab of the <u>Forms & Requisitions</u> section on the AHS Laboratory Services website or the Edmonton Zone tab of the <u>Forms and Resources</u> section of the provincial Transfusion Medicine website.

Background

• In preparation for implementation of the provincial Transfusion Service Identification Number (TSIN) system in Edmonton Zone and fAspen North Zone sites on May 6, 2023, printing of the current Edmonton Zone Transfusion Medicine requisition (CH-0025) through DATA CM has been ramping down. However, stock of the requisition has been depleted sooner than anticipated. The requisition can still be accessed and printed via AHS website or the Transfusion Medicine website as needed.
