## **Key Message:**

• Effective December 2, 2020, first trimester prenatal screen reports for screens performed by Alberta Precision Laboratories-North Sector will be available in Netcare

#### Why this is important:

• Prior to December 2, 2020 first trimester prenatal screen reports performed by Alberta Precision Laboratories (APL)-North Sector were not available in Netcare. Access to these reports in Netcare enhances patient care as patients transfer between different care providers during pregnancy.

#### **Action Required:**

- Access first trimester prenatal screen reports in Netcare under the Chemistry tab for screens
  performed by APL-North Sector. APL-North Sector performs first trimester prenatal screens on
  samples collected in North, Edmonton, and Central Zones.
- Distribution of reports will not be otherwise effected. The laboratory will continue to mail screen negative reports to ordering physicians and fax positive screen results.
- For screens reported prior to December 2, 2020 providers can contact client response at 780-407-7484 for reports.
