Key Message

• We are writing to bring your attention to an important update regarding the requisition process for skin biopsies, particularly those related to inflammatory conditions. As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance efficiency and reduce turnaround times, we have implemented new protocols for handling inflammatory skin biopsies.

Background

 The prior process for inflammatory skin conditions did not trigger an upfront special stain protocol causing potential delays to case sign out. The new process allows for the protocol to be ordered at the time of specimen receipt based on the ordering and clinical history provided by the clinician.

Action Required

 To ensure the smooth implementation of these protocols and to expedite the processing of inflammatory skin biopsy specimens, we kindly request all physicians to carefully review and complete the requisition form by checking the designated box for inflammatory skin biopsies.
