# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

#### **Key Message**

- Effective immediately, collection requirements have changed for non-gyne cytology specimens collected in community rural clinics, and rural hospitals in the Central Zone.
- Specimens will now need to be collected **fresh** and will be forwarded to the Edmonton DynaLIFE Base Lab for processing.

### **Background**

• This collection requirement change is necessary to support the transition of community/rural testing to DynaLIFE that began on December 5, 2022.

#### How this will impact you

- Non-gyne cytology community/rural hospital specimens will need to be collected fresh (no fixative to be added) in a sterile container to be forwarded to the Edmonton DynaLIFE Base Lab for processing.
  - No changes to test ordering are required
  - No changes to result reporting will occur
- There is no change to Red Deer Regional Hospital non-gyne cytology collection requirements.

#### **Action Required**

- Non-gyne cytology specimens are to be submitted as fresh samples in a sterile container. For more

- Do not add fixative.
