Re: North Sector Standardization of Breast Resection Inking

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Inking of breast resection specimens has been standardized across Edmonton and the rest of the North Sector. A 6-color inking scheme will be used.
- As of November 01, 2020, all Surgeons who ink their own breast resection specimens must also follow the standardized inking code.
- As of November 01, 2020, all breast resection cases must be inked using the Cancer Diagnostics brand of tissue marking dye.

Why this is important:

- Standardization of inking assists Pathologists with the interpretation and sign-out of breast resection cases.
- Ink quality between brands varies, and after a study was undertaken, the Cancer Diagnostics brand was selected by Pathologists for use.

Action Required:

 Surgeons inking their own breast resection specimens must follow the 6-color standardized ink scheme below:

Margin	Ink Color
Anterior	Red
Inferior	Green
Lateral	Yellow
Medial	Orange
Posterior	Black
Superior	Blue
