Key Message

 Effective April 1, 2023, the requirements for Transfusion Medicine cord blood sample collections will change. The red top tube will no longer be collected and instead an EDTA tube (either 7mL pink or 4mL lavender) will be collected.

Background

• Historically, the red top tube for cord blood samples has been collected. The change to the EDTA tube will standardize the North Zone Meditech sites with the rest of the province.
