- Booking of these samples drop offs will allow predicatibility of workflow and a consistent patient experience.

- Patients requiring this testing must book an appointment for this testing by calling the number indicated on the requisition for the site listed.
- On line bookings for post vasectomy and fertility testing is not available.
- Appointment times vary per site based upon capacity
