Re: Referral of Amylase testing to Calgary

PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

Key Message:

- Effective December 15, 2020, serum and fluid amylase will no longer be measured at Chinook Regional Hospital in Lethbridge and will be referred to the Diagnostic Scientific Centre in Calgary.
- Anticipated turnaround time is 24 hours.
- Results will be available in Netcare and Physician Office Systems (POS).

Why this is Important:

- Lipase has supplanted Amylase for diagnosis of acute pancreatitis, as Amylase is nonspecific and may arise from either salivary glands as well as the pancreas.
- The clinical utility of Amylase is mostly limited to diagnosis of salivary gland disease or some forms of malignancy.

Action Required:

- Order AMYRO for Amylase, serum testing. Refer to the APL Test Directory <u>Amylase</u> for instructions.
- Order AMYFLURO for Amylase, fluid testing. Refer to the APL Test Directory <u>Amylase, Fluid</u> for instructions.
