#### **Key Message**

- On March 1, 2022, PDF reports from the Edmonton Histocompatibility (HLA) Laboratory will be revised with the following changes:
  - NEW\* Antibody Screening Report has been limited to Luminex Screen testing and a new Antibody Identification Report has been created for Single Antigen Bead test results.
  - NEW\* Virtual Crossmatch Report has been created.
  - Changes to report titles as follows:

- NOTE that only the PDF reports are changing—the results transferred to Connect Care remain the same. Test codes in Connect Care also remain the same, the specific PDF report needed will be generated by the HLA lab.

## Background

 Revision of PDF reports from the Edmonton Histocompatibility Laboratory has been requested by the Laboratory's Directors to provide more clarity to clinical programs as to what information is on the report.



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## How this will impact you

- The new Histocompatibility reports will provide more useful and clearer information to clinicians:
  - The antibody reports will now separate out screen results from single antigen bead results.
    Cumulative antigens with cPRA will remain on both reports.
    - The HLA Antibody Identification Report will report out the single antigen bead test results.
    - The HLA Antibody Screening Report will report the test result for the antibody screen.
  - The Virtual Crossmatch Report will show results of virtual HLA crossmatches on a report separate from HLA allo-crossmatches.

## **Action Required**

No action is required for the revised reports. Resulting in Connect Care remains unchanged.

#### **Effective**

The new Histocompatibility reports will be in effect on March 1, 2022.
