Key Message

- Staffing shortages at the Medicine Hat Regional Hospital laboratory have resulted in challenges in meeting the demand for routine testing volumes.
- Routine hematology CBC and ESR samples collected at the Carry Drive Patient Care Centre in Medicine Hat will be forwarded to DSC in Calgary for testing for a minimum of 4 months with ongoing assessment of the situation.

Background

 MHRH laboratory is unable to maintain consistent staffing due to vacancies, medical leave of absences, and training demands.

How this will impact you

- Tests sent to DSC will have increased turn around time due to transportation. Please advise patients accordingly should test results be required within a specific timeframe.
- No change to ordering.
- Results will not be visible in Meditech, however all other reporting mechanisms will continue (i.e. paper, POSP, Netcare).
