# **Key Message**

- Due to instrumentation challenges, staffing pressure and commitment to ongoing projects (Roche
  implementation and Care validation), effective July 12, 2021, the Chemistry department located at the
  Chinook Regional Hospital, will temporarily refer out testing for Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) to the
  Diagnostic Scientific Centre, Calgary. Referred out testing will remain in place until implantation of new
  Chemistry analyzers.
- Anticipated turnaround time is 24 72 hours depending on time of collection.
- Results will be available in Netcare and Physician Office Systems (POS).

## How this will impact you

• When a HBA1C is ordered after July 12, 2021, there will be a pop up indicating that HBA1C is currently unavailable. There will be no impact to specimen collection procedures.

#### **Action Required**

Order HBA1CRO as the temporary test code in a separate order.
