Key Message

- Effective **July 19, 2021**, COVID-19 samples collected at South Zone Assessment Centres will be tested at Alberta Precision Laboratories (APL) in Calgary. Testing will no longer be performed at the National Microbiology Laboratory (NML) Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) site in Lethbridge.
- The NML worked with public health laboratories nation-wide, including the APL-Public Health Laboratory, to provide surge testing capacity for COVID-19 during peak testing waves. With the current low testing volumes, APL no longer requires surge capacity.

Why this is important

• As COVID-19 testing volumes in Alberta continue to decrease, the province is moving into a state of readiness and recovery.

Actions Required

- Samples will be routed to the appropriate testing site by the Laboratory. No further action is required.
- Results will continue to be available on Netcare. All downstream reporting and notification processes remain unchanged.
