

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Following the instructions below is important for providing you with accurate test results.

Specimen will **not** be tested if label or requisition is missing information.

Do not urinate (pee) for **1 to 2 hours** before collection.

<div>Jane Doe 12345 6700 Date Jan 3 Time 9:00am</div>		<div>1. Make sure the cup is labelled with all of the following:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Full first and last name○ Healthcare number○ Date and time of collection
		<div>2. Wash your hands with soap and water.</div> <div>3. Dry your hands, using paper or cloth towel, if possible.</div>
		<div>4. Remove the lid from the container.</div> <div>5. Place the lid upside down on a counter.</div>
		<div>Do not touch the inside of the cup with your fingers</div> <div>6. Urinate (pee) into the cup between the two lines. Then stop. Do not pour urine out if you go past the line .</div> <div>7. Finish urinating into the toilet.</div>
		<div>Do not overfill the cup</div> <div>8. Put the lid on the cup.</div> <div>9. Place the cup in the designated area or give to a laboratory staff member.</div> <div>10. Wash your hands with soap and water.</div>

If collecting at home:

- Place specimen and requisition in the bag you were given.
- Refrigerate the specimen, if more than 20 mins between collection and going to the laboratory.
- Take the specimen and the requisition to the laboratory today.
- Lab staff will confirm your name and Healthcare number when you deliver the specimen to the laboratory.
