	2.	Wash your hands with soap and water.
	3.	Dry your hands, using paper or cloth towel, if possible.
	4.	Remove the lid from the containers
	5.	Place the lids upside down on a counter.
		Do not touch the inside of the cup with your fingers
	1.	Urinate (pee) into the first cup between the two lines. Then stop. Do not pour urine out if you go past the line
	2.	Urinate into the second cup until it is $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ full.
	3.	Stop urinating into the cup before you are finished.
	4.	Finish urinating into the toilet.
		Do not overfill the cup
	1.	Put the lids on the cups.
	2.	Place the cup in the designated area or give to a laboratory staff member.
	3.	Wash your hands with soap and water.
If collecting at home: Place specimen and requisition in the hag you were given		

- Place specimen and requisition in the bag you were given.
- Refrigerate the specimen, if more than 20 mins between collection and going to the laboratory.
- Take the specimen and the requisition to the laboratory today.
- Lab staff will confirm your name and Healthcare number when you deliver the specimen to the laboratory.
