Following the instructions below is important for providing you with accurate test results. Specimen will **not** be tested if label or requisition is missing information.

- 1. Make sure the cup is labelled with **all** of the following:
 - o Full first and last name
 - Healthcare number
 - Date and time of collection



- 2. Wash your hands with soap and water.
- 3. Dry your hands, using paper or cloth towel, if possible.



- 4. Remove the lid from the container.
- 5. Place the lid **upside down** on a counter.

Do not touch the inside of the cup with your fingers





- 1. Urinate (pee) into the cup until it is ¼ to ½ full. Then stop.
- 2. Finish urinating into the toilet.

Do not overfill the cup





- 1. Secure the lid on the cup.
- 2. Place the cup in the designated area or give to a laboratory staff member.
- 3. Wash your hands with soap and water.

Note: This specimen cannot be collected at home.
