Booking Home Parenteral Therapy Program - HPTP - Appointments - Calgary Zone

Prior to booking your appointment:

Have the following information available:

- Your requisition.
- Time, frequency and duration that your physician requires you to get your blood test drawn.
- Your desired Patient Service Centre location and an alternate location.
- Your contact phone number.

Note: Appointments are not available at all locations.

Booking your appointment:

HPTP appointments must be made by telephone bookings only

Patient Appointment Line: **403-770-5136** Monday to Friday 7:30 am – 5:30 pm

- Identify yourself as a HPTP patient.
- Inform the agent that your physician has ordered a pre-drug level and indicate the time, frequency and duration.

Note: Appointments will be scheduled approximately 1 hour before dose time.

Cancelling or rescheduling your appointment:

The day of your appointment:

- Bring your lab requisition, Provincial Healthcare Card and a piece of government issued photo ID (such as your driver's license or passport).
- You will be required to present this information at the front desk.
- At check in, inform staff that you are a HPTP patient requiring a pre-drug level prior to dose.

Note: If you arrive late to your appointment, APL cannot guarantee your blood test will be drawn before your required dose time. You may be asked to reschedule your appointment or be processed as a walk-in patient.
