Sputum Cytology – Calgary and South Zones

How to Prepare

- An early morning collection is recommended.
- Brush your teeth and rinse your mouth with water thoroughly prior to sample collection.
- Remove lid from sterile container. **DO NOT** touch the inside of the container or the lid.

<u>Note:</u> Your doctor may request 3 samples. These samples must be collected 3 days in a row in 3 separate containers. Three separate requisitions should be provided to you by your doctor.

Risks or Cautions

- Saliva and/or postnasal discharge are not acceptable samples.
- You will have to repeat the collection if your specimen container:
 - is not correctly and completely labelled
 - o is frozen or stored at high temperatures

Labelling the Specimen

Label the collection container with the following information:

- Your (the patient) full first and last name
- The date and time of specimen collection
- Your unique personal health number (PHN or ULI#)

Alberta PHN is found on the Alberta Personal Health Card



If you do not have a PHN or ULI please ask your local laboratory for alternatives. Please note all specimens need 2 identifiers to be processed.

Lab Requisition

- Print the date and time the sample was collected on your lab requisition.
- Fold and place the requisition in the outside pocket of the plastic bag.

Collecting the Specimen

- 1. Take a few deep breaths and cough deeply from your chest.
- 2. The specimen from your lungs is called sputum, which should be thick (compared to saliva which is thin and clear).
- 3. Put the sputum into the container.
- 4. Close the container lid tightly.
- 5. Place the container into the biohazard bag.

Specimen Delivery to Lab

- Bring your specimen and requisition to your local laboratory as soon as possible.
- If you are unable to deliver the specimen to the lab immediately, refrigerate the specimen and bring it to the lab within 24 hours.
