**Urine Cytology - Central Zone** 

How to Prepare	• For cytology testing you may be asked to collect one sample or three samples. If three samples are required the three samples <b>must be collected on three different days</b> .
Risks or Cautions	<ul> <li>A WHMIS label will be attached to the container containing Cytology fixative.</li> <li>For each sample required you will be given an empty sterile container and one container with 30ml of cytology fixative. NOTE: Cytology Fixative is extremely flammable and toxic.</li> </ul>
Labelling the Specimen	<ul> <li>Label the collection container with the following information:</li> <li>Your (the patient) <u>full first and last name</u></li> <li><u>The date and time of specimen collection</u></li> <li>Your unique personal health number (PHN or ULI#) Alberta PHN is found on the Alberta Personal Health Card</li> <li>If you do not have a PHN or ULI please ask your local laboratory for alternatives. Please note all specimens need 2 identifiers to be processed.</li> </ul>
Lab Requisition	<ul> <li>Print the date and time the sample was collected on your lab requisition.</li> <li>Fold and place the requisition in the <u>outside</u> pocket of the plastic bag.</li> </ul>
Collecting the Specimen	<ol> <li>Lab will give you towelettes, sterile container(s) and container(s) with cytology fixative.</li> <li>Wash your hands with soap and water.</li> <li>Open the urine container.</li> <li>Open the towelette packages.</li> <li>FEMALE         <ul> <li>Sit as far back on the toilet as possible.</li> <li>Spread both legs apart.</li> <li>Cleanse the genital area with the towelettes:                 <ul> <li>Hold the outer edges of your labia apart.</li> <li>With 1<sup>st</sup> towelette wipe from front to back.</li> <li>With 2<sup>nd</sup> towelette wipe from front to back again.</li> <li>Continue to hold the labia apart until the urine sample is collected.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> <li>MALE         <ul> <li>Pull the foreskin of the penis back (if applicable).</li> <li>Cleanse the head of the penis with the towelettes:</li></ul></li></ol>

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	<ol> <li>Tightly screw on the lid of the container. Gently shake the container to mix the cytology fixative and urine.</li> <li>Label your specimen container containing the fixative with the following:</li> <li>Full first and last name.</li> <li>Personal Health Insurance Number or Unique Lifetime Identifier or Government Issued Identification number or Medical Record Number.</li> <li>Date and time of collection.</li> </ol>
Specimen Delivery to Lab	<ul> <li>Refrigerate the sample until delivered to the laboratory.</li> <li>You can either return the samples to the laboratory each day, or return them together at the end of the three days, within 24 hours of the third collection.</li> </ul>
