

Phlebotomy Aftercare for Mobile Labs



To reduce the potential risks after blood collection

Apply immediate pressure to puncture site for at least 5 minutes.

Leave bandage on for a minimum of 5 minutes, and longer if necessary.

Avoid lifting heavy objects and use other arm for at least 2 hours.

If you experience symptoms related to the risks of blood collection (bruising or bleeding from puncture site, minor discomfort, tingling of the arm and/or painful swelling), please contact your family physician.


