Specimen will not be tested if label or requisition is missing information.

At your physician's appointment	Discuss your  medications  and  get  your  physician's  approval  before  stopping  any  medication.				
4 weeks before the collection	Do <b>not</b> take any antibiotics.				
2 weeks before the collection	Do <b>not</b> take bismuth preparations (Pepto Bismol).				
2 weeks before the collection	Do not take proton pump inhibitors:  LOSEC® (Omeprazole magnesium)  Prevacid (Lansoprazole)  Pantoloc (Pantoprazole sodium)  Tecta (Pantoprazole magnesium)  Nexium (Esomeprazole)  Pariet® (Rabeprazole sodium)

collection	<ul> <li>Antacids (Tums, Rolaids)</li> <li>Histamine H2 receptor antagonists:         <ul> <li>Zantac (Ranitidine HCl)</li> <li>Tagamet (Cimetidine)</li> <li>Pepcid AC (Famotidine)</li> <li>Axid (Nizatidine)</li> <li>Pylorid (Ranitidine Bismuth Citrate)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>				
Day of Collection:	<ul> <li>Write full last and first name and health care number of the patient on the container.</li> <li>Write date and time of collection on container.</li> <li>Empty bladder (pee) completely before stool is collected. Do not let urine mix with the stool (poo) specimen.</li> <li>Collect stool onto a clean, disposable container. For example, a paper plate <u>OR</u> put plastic wrap between the toilet seat and the bowl and collect the stool onto the wrap. Do not let water touch the stool.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Using the wooden stick, add stool specimen to the container until one third filled only. Make sure nothing else gets in the container (i.e. no toilet paper, no plastic wrap).</li> <li>Close the container with the lid. Please ensure the lid is tightly closed and not leaking.</li> <li>Put the container into the ziplock bag and close the bag.</li> <li>Wash your hands with soap and water.</li> </ul>				
	Put the requisition in the pouch of the bag.				
Diapers:	<ul> <li>Do <b>not</b> bring used diapers to the laboratory.</li> <li>At home, please remove the stool from the diaper using the wooden stick provided and put</li> </ul>				

When Finished:

Specimen  $\underline{\text{MUST}}$  be refrigerated or kept on an ice pack until taken to the laboratory.

	<ul> <li>Take the specimen and requisition to the laboratory as soon as possible – must be deliver to the lab within 12 hours of collection.</li> </ul>			
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
