Specimen will not be tested if label or requisition is missing information.


Please follow the instructions below for accurate test results.

- The best time to collect the specimen is right after getting out of bed in the morning.
- Gargle or rinse your mouth with water.
- Do not brush your teeth immediately before collection.
- Open the cup.
- Hold the cup very close to your mouth.
- Take a deep breath and cough deeply from your chest.
- The specimen from your lungs is called sputum.
- Put the sputum into the cup. Sputum should be thick, not watery.
- Sputum may be yellow or green.
- A minimum of 15 mL or 1 tablespoon of sputum is required.
- Please do **not** put saliva from your mouth into the cup.
- Put the lid on the cup and close tightly.

Make sure the cup is labeled with all of the following:

- Full first and last name
- Alberta Healthcare number
- Date and time of collection
- Put the specimen cup in the section of the bag that closes and close the ziplock.
- Wash your hands with soap and water.
- Put your requisition in the outer pocket of the bag.
- Take the specimen and the requisiton to the laboratory as soon as possible.
- Specimen must arrive in the laboratory within 2 hours of collection.
- Store in refrigerator if not going directly to the laboratory.
