



Red Deer Regional Hospital Outpatient Lab Service Restrictions

The Red Deer Regional Hospital Outpatient Laboratory is available to serve Ambulatory Clinic patients, immunocompromised patients and patients requiring special collections. Blood collection does not have to be on the same day as the Ambulatory Clinic visit. Services are available by physician / clinic referral only.

Definitions:

| Ambulatory Clinic patient | Patients that receive medical service at a hospital on an outpatient basis. |
| Immunocompromised patient | Patients that are taking immunosuppressive drugs/treatment, experiencing illness/injury or have an inherited disease affecting the immune system. |
| Special collections | Samples that require special handling, are not available at PSCs, or can only be collected in hospital outpatient labs. |
| Referral | The formal process through which a health care provider arranges an appointment with another health care provider who provides specialist treatment or assessment. |
