### Key Messages:

Effective, July 18, 2012 at 5:00 PM, results for Chlamydia trachomatis (CT) and Neisseria gonorrhoeae (GC) swabs referred to *DynaLIFE<sub>Dx</sub>* for processing will be located in the microbiology folder in the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV) tree of Netcare. This change will align the location of these results in Netcare to the current practice across the province.

### Why this is important:

Prior to July 18, 2012, results for CT and GC swabs were mapped into the chemistry folder of the CDV tree in the Netcare display. Beginning July 18, 2012, these results will be moved to the microbiology folder in the CDV.

Results for CT and GC urines are unaffected by this change and will continue to be found in the microbiology folder in the CDV tree of Netcare.
