Re: West Nile Virus (WNV) Diagnostic Testing Update

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West Nile Virus (WNV) Diagnostic Testing Update

Seasonal testing for West Nile Virus (WNV), including the work-up of encephalitis and pretransplant assessment, ended on November 1, 2010. WNV testing by serology and molecular assays remains available by specific request, provided that a qualifying reason is given (typically travel in an endemic area where the virus is currently actively transmitted).

The 2010 WNV season in Alberta was very quiet, with only one case confirmed by laboratory testing (sero-conversion). It is unclear exactly where the patient was infected as the diagnosis was made shortly after the patient returned from out of the province.
