Re: Anticipated Delayed Turn-Around-Times for Biochemical Genetics South Test Results

Key Message:

 As a result of staffing shortages and current Connect Care project demands during the months of October through December 2020, delays are anticipated in reporting turn-around times (TAT) for testing performed at the Biochemical Genetics South laboratory located at the Alberta Children's Hospital, Calgary.

Why this is important:

- Testing will be prioritized based on the essential test menu, indication(s) for testing/reason for referral provided on the requisition, and through direct communication with the geneticist on-service by the ordering physician.
- Biochemical Genetics South laboratory may send out testing to Biochemical Genetics North or out-of-province referral labs, as needed, to avoid delayed TAT for samples requiring timely followup that cannot be performed in-house.

Action Required:

- Provide sufficient indication for testing when placing orders via EPIC/Beaker or via paper requisition.
- When placing orders outside of EPIC/Beaker, ensure the newest version of the <u>Genetics and</u> <u>Genomics Biochemical Genetics Requisition</u> is used.
