# PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

## Key Messages:

- Routine autopsy results (adult, pediatric, neuropathology and perinatal) will be available on Netcare from all Laboratory Information Systems (LIS) effective June 19, 2014.
- The Calgary Zone Cerner LIS has been reporting Autopsy results to Netcare since October 31, 2013.
- <u>Medical Examiner Autopsy results are excluded</u> as under the Alberta Fatalities Inquiry Act, these cannot be released without the permission of the Chief Medical Examiner.
- In order for the Stillbirth Autopsies to be viewable/searchable in Netcare, the client must have an accessible Medical Report Number (i.e.: an assigned Unique Lifetime Identifier (ULI)).

## Why this is important:

- Autopsy results form part of the overall patient Health Record. Availability of these results on Netcare helps to:
  - o Ensure complete clinical information is available for every patient
  - o Facilitate Morbidity and Mortality rounds
  - Support Clinical-Pathology Correlation
